# **4 FIRST-AID MEASURES**

## INHALATION

Remove victim immediately from source of exposure. Move the exposed person to fresh air at once. Get medical attention.

# INGESTION

Rinse mouth thoroughly with water and give large amounts of milk or water to people not unconscious. Do not induce vomiting. If vomiting occurs, the head should be kept low so that stomach vomit doesn't enter the lungs. Get medical attention.

#### SKIN CONTACT

Wash skin with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists after washing.

#### **EYE CONTACT**

Promptly wash eyes with plenty of water while lifting the eye lids. Continue to rinse for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention promptly if symptoms occur after washing.

# **5 FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES**

## **EXTINGUISHING MEDIA**

Extinguish with foam, carbon dioxide, dry powder or water fog.

#### SPECIAL FIRE FIGHTING PROCEDURES

Be aware of danger of explosion. Use pressurised air mask if product is involved in a fire.

# UNUSUAL FIRE & EXPLOSION HAZARDS

May explode when heated or when exposed to flames or sparks. Aerosol cans may explode in a fire.
